Identify Your Energy Abusers

With the Kill A Watt electricity usage monitor you can find out what appliances are actually worth keeping plugged in. Simply connect any household appliance to the Kill A Watt, and it will assess how efficient they really are. The large LCD will display the power consumption by the kilowatt hour which is the measure we bill you for each month. With Kill A Watt you'll know if it is time to unplug that old refrigerator in the garage or replace an old energy inefficient appliance with a new energy efficient one. We'll let you borrow one from us (deposit required) or purchase one for only \$35.
