Weather the Storm

As spring draws near so does the possibility of severe weather. Weather can be extremely unpredictable and dangerous. Use these tips to keep you and your family safe in the face of a storm.

BEFORE THE STORM:

-Assemble a kit of essentials, like water, battery-operated flashlights, and radios. Keep a list of emergency phone numbers, including your electric utility. Be prepared for the possibility of a prolonged outage due to power line and electric equipment damage.

-Consider installing ground fault circuit interrupters (GFCIs) or purchasing a portable GFCI. GFCIs detect dangerous electrical situations and cut off power before a person can be shocked. These dangerous electrical situations are likely to occur around water, so GFCIs should be installed in bathrooms, laundry rooms, kitchens, basements, outdoors and anywhere else water and electricity may meet.

-If power goes out, switch off lights, large electronics and appliances to prevent overloading circuits and damaging appliances when power is restored. Leave one lamp or switch on as a signal for when your power returns.

AFTER THE STORM:

-When going outside stay away from downed electrical lines and be aware that fallen trees and other debris can hide electrical dangers.

-Don't step into a flooded area if the water goes up past the outlets

-When entering a storm-damaged building always make sure that the electric is turned off. Never attempt to turn off power at the breaker box if you must stand in water to do so.

-Do not use water-damaged electric items until a qualified electrician inspects them and ensures they are safe.
