

Managing Your Account & Paying Online is Easy with SmartHub

Cooperative's online bill payment will have a new look, be easier to use, and offer more features. SmarthHub, a free app for computers and mobile devices, will replace eBill to provide members with secure account management right at their fingertips.

"One of the best ways for members to reduce their electric bill is to monitor their use," said Mark Forseth, CWEC Vice President of Member Relations. "SmartHub uses advanced technology



so members can see their electric usage on a daily, weekly, and monthly basis. It's also possible to compare usage from month to month or from any two time periods."

With SmartHub, you can:

- Check your usage.
- Contact our office.
- Pay your bill.
- Receive account notifications.
- Report an outage.
- Sign up for paperless billing.

Members who already have an eBill account will be able to log in to SmartHub using their same user ID and password. If you are new to online account management, you will need to sign up for SmartHub as a new user. All you need is your account number, account holder's last name, and email address.

The mobile app is available for both android and iPhones. Simply look for SmartHub in the Apple Store or the Google Play Store.

Energy Assistance Programs For 2015-2016

Electric Assistance

If you've received your electricity from Central Wisconsin Electric Co-op for six months or longer and your gross household income meets the guidelines shown below you may be eligible for assistance. Electric assistance is an annual benefit payment. The amount of assistance varies depending on a variety of factors, including the household's size, income and annual electric costs.

To apply please submit verification of your income along with a statement indicating how many are in the household. Acceptable forms of income verification are:

- I. Most recent tax return
- 2. Copy of a bank statement showing direct deposit amount
- Most recent pay stub

If approved, assistance will be done as a credit to your electric account. For electric assistance CWEC members can call 1-800-377-2932

Crisis Assistance

A co-op household may be eligible for crisis assistance if the family has experienced a tragedy that has placed a financial burden on the family. Additional funds for these families may be available through the co-op's Operation Round Up program. Please contact the co-op for more information on crisis assistance.

Heating and Weatherization Assistance

If your gross household income meets the guidelines set below you may be eligible to receive home heating assistance through Wisconsin's Home Energy Assistance Program (WHEAP). If you meet WHEAP income eligibility guidelines, you may also qualify for assistance in furnace repair or replacement, caulking, weather-stripping and insulation. For more information on the WHEAP Program and how to apply, please contact the appropriate county agency listed below.
